

How to use Knowledge Organisers at home:

Every half term, your child will be given a new Knowledge Organiser linked to their Learning Journey theme. This will help both you and your child to understand exactly what your child will be learning about and to know what terminology you could use when discussing their Learning Journey work at home.

Your child can use the Knowledge Organiser to reinforce key knowledge and vocabulary linked to their current Learning Journey.

Your child might choose to:

1. Make a set of flashcards that include all of knowledge items for one section. Use them in spare moments for self-quizzing.
2. Ask someone at home to quiz you on a knowledge item.
3. Practice spelling key vocabulary.
4. Self-quiz by using a blank piece of paper to cover the definitions of each key word on the glossary, write down the associated definition of each term, then check your answers. OR cover the key words and then see if you can remember the term that matches each definition.
5. List facts from your knowledge organiser for 1 minute straight, without repetition, hesitation or deviation! ('Just a Minute' style!)
6. Create a topic map from your Knowledge Organiser with words and images. (See below)
7. Use your Knowledge Organiser as inspiration for additional research.
