Dear Parents and Carers,

Request for nominations for two Parent Local Advisors at Emmbrook Junior School

I am writing to let you know that we have two elected Parent Local Advisor vacancies on the Local Advisory Board (LAB) of our school and to invite nominations from parents, carers and guardians who wish to stand for election to put their names forward.

Attached you will find:

- a nomination form.

If you wish to stand for election you **must**:

- complete the attached nomination form <u>and</u> sign it, providing full details so we can contact you if we need to;
- have your nomination supported by a proposer and seconder, who are parents or carers of a child registered at the school (you may nominate yourself); and
- return the completed nomination form to the School Office in an envelope clearly marked
 "For the attention of the Returning Officer, Emmbrook Junior School Parent Local Advisor
 election" by 10.00 am on Wednesday, 24 January 2024. No nomination will be accepted
 after that date and time.

You may if you wish include with your completed nomination form a brief personal statement for circulation to voters, should a ballot be required.

If you are unable to print off the nomination form, one can be obtained on request from the School Office.

The Election Process

If there are two nominations received or only one, the person(s) nominated will be elected automatically without a ballot.

If more than two nominations are received, an election will be held.

If an election is held we are proposing to use a secure online voting software system. If, however, you would like to receive a hard copy ballot form, please complete the slip at the bottom of this letter and return it to the School Office, if possible, by 10.00 am on Wednesday, 24 January 2024. We will send the ballot form to you by first-class post.

If you have not registered an email address with the school and wish to do so or if there has been a change to your email address, please notify the school by contacting the School Office as soon as possible and before 10.00 am on Wednesday, 24 January 2024.

If it is necessary to hold an election, we intend to apply the following timetable:

Friday, 26 January 2024 – Election launched - candidates announced and voting opens

Thursday, 8 February 2024 at **10.00 am** – Online voting closes and last day and time for return of hard copy ballot papers to the School Office

Thursday, 8 February 2024 at 3.30 pm – Election count and result declared

All candidates are welcome to attend the election count and all parents and carers will be notified of the result.

A copy of the rules of the election may be inspected at the School Office and is available on the school website.
