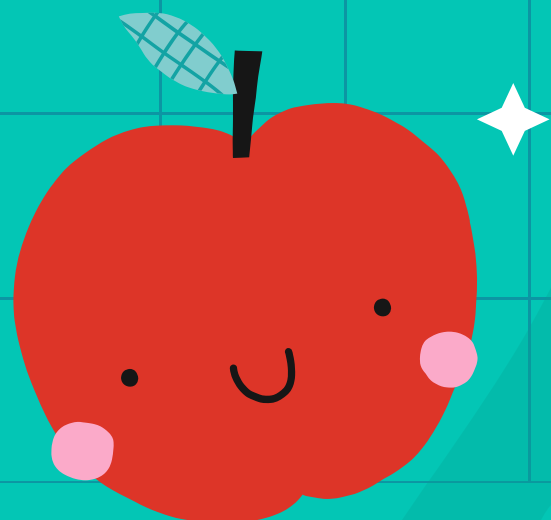




I'M MOVING TO YEAR 3

Hello!

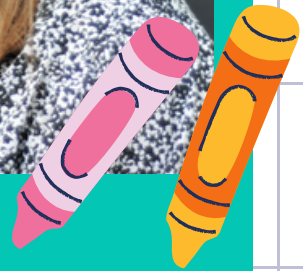
My name is Mrs Bendall and I am really looking forward to getting to you know you all when I teach you on Transition Day and in September.

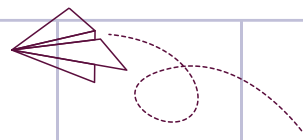

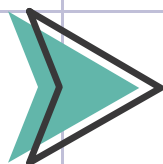

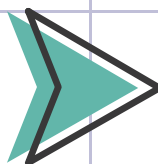

Q. Where are the Year 3 toilets?

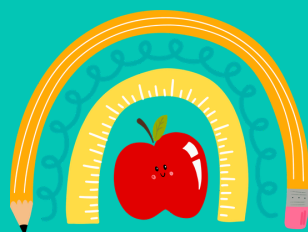
A. The toilets are located outside the classroom in the cloakroom.
