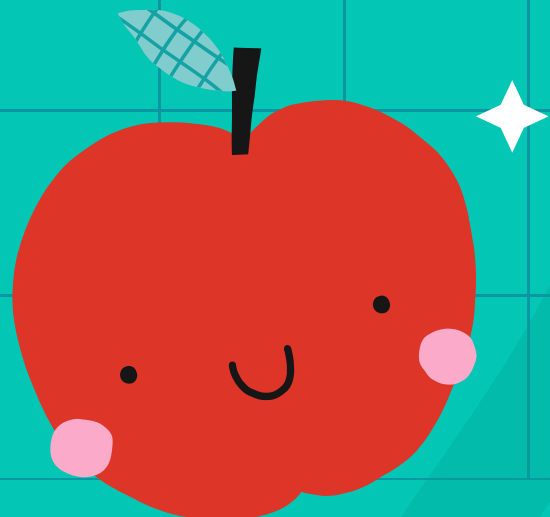


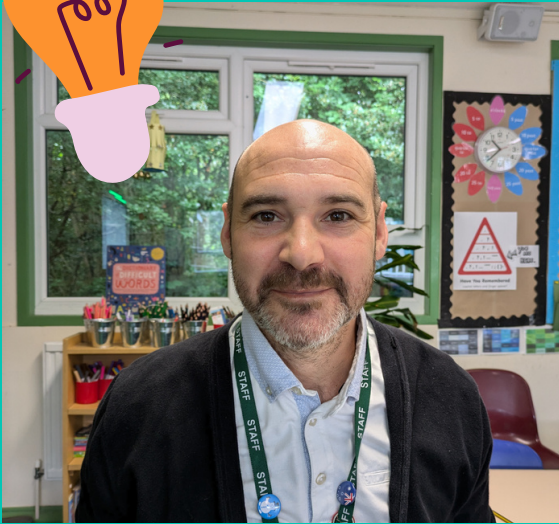
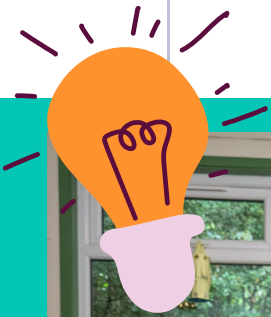


I'M MOVING TO YEAR 4

Mrs Jones

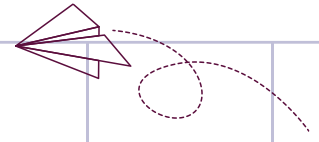
My name is Mrs Jones. I will be your class teacher for most of the week next year!

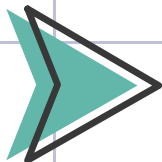

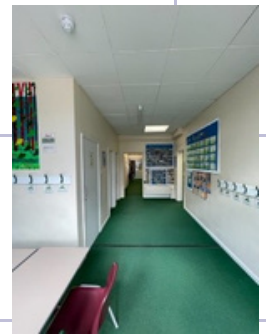
**How do I get to my classroom from

Q: Where are the Year 4 toilets?

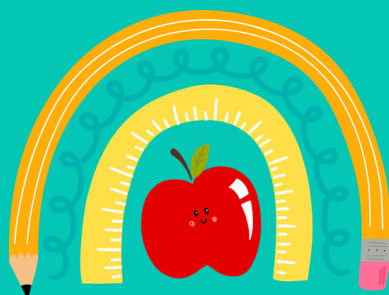
A: The toilets are located in the corridor near to the ICT suite.
