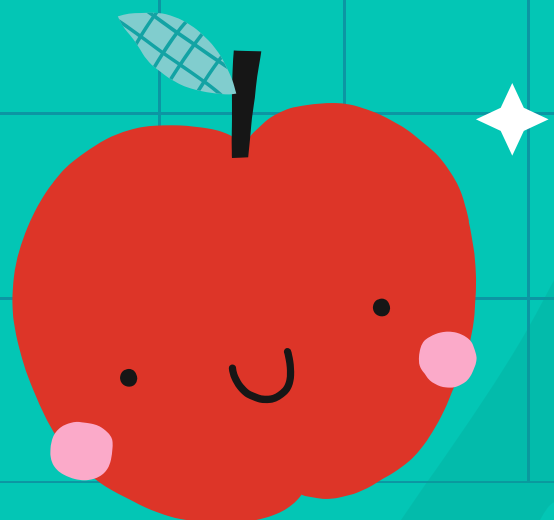




I'M MOVING TO YEAR 5

Mrs Furnell

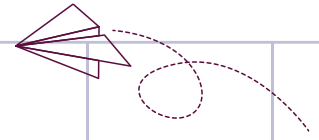

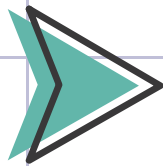

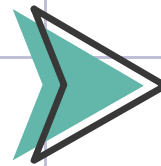
**How do I get to my classroom from

turn left at the corridor



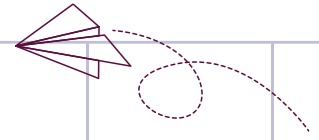

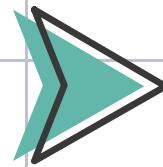
